



**UPDATE: Additional FL Counties Added
Suspension of Binding Authority - Hurricane Ian**

Issued On: **Tuesday, September 27, 2022**

Effective Date: **Immediately**

Territory Impacted: **Florida**

Lines Impacted: **Property, Inland Marine, Ocean Marine, Auto
Dealers/Garage Physical Damage and Garagekeepers**

Due to the uncertainty of the path of **Hurricane Ian** in the Gulf of Mexico **the following Florida counties have been added** to the moratorium below:
**Osceola, Orange, Brevard, Seminole, Volusia, Flagler, Putnam, Bradford,
Union, Hamilton, Columbia, Baker, St Johns, Clay, Duval, Nassau**

All binding authority is temporarily suspended for Property, Inland Marine, Environmental Property, Ocean Marine, Auto Dealers/Garage Physical Damage and Garagekeepers business.

In addition to the above added counties, the moratorium applies to all perils in the following Florida counties:

Monroe, Collier, Lee, Charlotte, Sarasota, DeSoto, Manatee, Hardee, Pinellas, Hillsborough, Pasco, Hernando, Sumter, Citrus, Marion, Levy, Dixie, Gilchrist, Alachua, Taylor, Lafayette, Suwanee, Madison, Jefferson, Wakulla, Leon, Franklin, Gulf, Liberty, Calhoun, Gadsden, Bay, Washington, Walton, Okaloosa, Santa Rosa, Escambia, Holmes, Jackson, Polk, Lake

This moratorium applies to the binding of any new business, as well as new additions and/or exposure or limit increases to existing policies. We ask that you immediately advise all your agency personnel of this suspension.
